



TRANSPORTATION FROM AIRPORTS



TAXI

From Ciampino (CIA) Airport to Castel Gandolfo (10 km)

The best option. The quickest way to get from Rome Ciampino Airport (CIA) to Castel Gandolfo is by taxi which costs €23 - €29 and takes 10-15 minutes.

From Fiumicino Airport to Castel Gandolfo (40 km)

The quickest way to get from Fiumicino Airport to Castel Gandolfo is by taxi which costs €85 - €100 and takes 30-40 min.

TRAIN

Train (1 change) - you must first take the train from **FIUMICINO AEROPORTO** to **ROMA TERMINI** station (Treno Leonardo Express);

then another train from **ROMA TERMINI** to **CASTEL GANDOLFO** (regional train) / 90' or 102' depending on the time / Leonardo train runs every 15 minutes,

while the regional train to **Castel Gandolfo** runs at: 7:21, 8:21, 9:00*, 12:21, 13:21, 14:21, 15:21, 16:21, 17:21, 18:21, 19:21, 20:21, 21:21* / cost 16.10 € /

You can get from Fiumicino Airport to Roma Termini quite quickly and change to the regional train to Castel Gandolfo. However, from the train station to the centre of Castel Gandolfo it is about 10-15 minutes on foot uphill. You can therefore arrange with the driver to pick you up from the station to your hotel.
